Our government's ability to serve the public depends on the strength, expertise and leadership of federal mission-support functions. While their work is usually done behind the scenes, it is imperative to build the leadership attributes of these professionals because of their wide-ranging impact, the interconnectedness of their work and their ability to positively shape strategic decisions.

The Advanced Human Resource Leaders Program, designed for GS-12 to GS-14 federal employees in human resources, prepares these mission-critical federal professionals to become better leaders by focusing on the four core tenets of the Partnership's Public Service Leadership Model: self-awareness, engaging others, leading change and achieving results. By the end of the course, participants will be able to make values-based decisions, use their roles to build strong partnerships, identify how to drive positive impact within their organizations and demonstrate enhanced leadership attributes.

HOW TO APPLY

AHRL participants are nominated by their agency. Training officers at agency members of the Federal Human Capital Collaborative will communicate directly with eligible employees and will submit information of selected participants directly to the Partnership. WHO SHOULD APPLY

Enrollment is open to high-performing, human resources professionals who have reached the GS-12 to GS-14 level and have at least three to five years of experience working in their field. To meet their guidelines, agencies may raise the level of qualifications.



LOCATION AND TIME COMMITMENT

All sessions will take place virtually from 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. ET, using the Zoom for Government platform. During the program, participants remain in their full-time jobs and meet every month, spending a total of 15 days in session, and devote three to five hours per week on session pre-work and group meetings. Participants are expected to attend all sessions, so applicants should review the class schedule and confirm their availability before applying to the program. Exceptions are made for family and work-related emergencies.
