WHO SHOULD APPLY

GS-14s and GS-15s (though we may accept a small number of high-performing GS-12s and GS-13s). Applicants should have an interest in improving workplace culture, growing professionally, discovering new methods and tools to operate more effectively and efficiently, and meeting fellow trail blazers.



APPLICATION CRITERIA

The application includes your personal information, responses to short-answer questions and permission from your supervisor to participate in the program. Participants must be approved for funding by their agency upon applying. Carefully consider short-answer responses to ensure your government career objectives align with the high expectations of Gov21 participants. We are looking for participants who are willing to attend all sessions, commit to learning and active participation, and want to use their federal job for good. While we aim to have a cohort of roughly 30 participants, we will be able to accept no more than 35.



LOCATION

The Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 cohorts will attend virtual sessions via Zoom for Government.



TIME COMMITMENT

The Gov21 program consists of three three-day, virtual sessions over the course of three months. Each half-day virtual session is noon to 4 p.m. ET. You are expected to prepare for and attend every session and complete any pre-work or readings assigned between sessions. Prior to applying to the program, please review the schedule and confirm your availability for all session dates.
